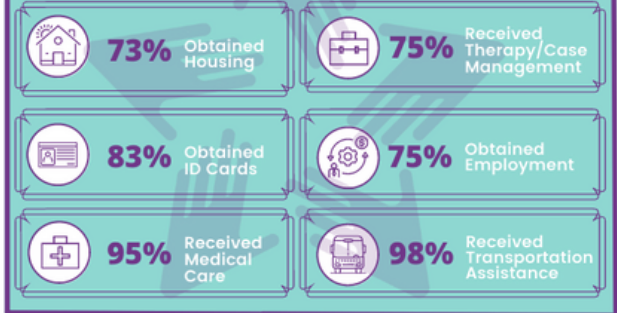

were provided emergency assistance through programs supported by Anthem, The Columbus Foundation Gifts of Kindness Fund, NeighborRelief and Caring Connections.



3,084 Clinical Service

appointments were provided to youth at our drop-in center and Carol Stewart Village.



6,261 Bus Passes

were provided to youth, enabling them to attend purposeful appointments. Transportation is an essential stabilizing resource.



39 Social Service Partners

provided access to supportive services for youth at our drop-in center and CSV.



94% of CSV Residents

participated in social service programs.



1,872 Gallons of Milk

were provided to youth at our drop-in center.
