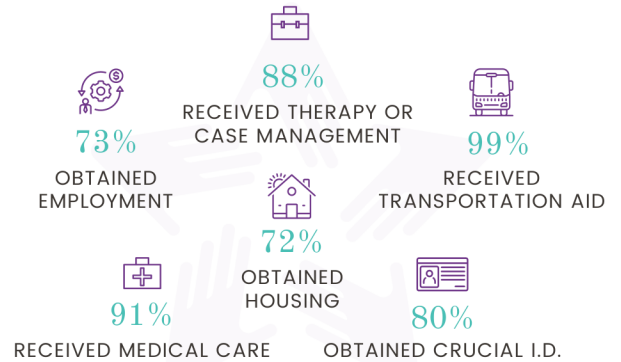

80% of CSV Residents

participated in social service programs.

4,394 Clinical Service Appointments

were provided to youth at our drop-in center and Carol Stewart Village.



9,145 Bus Passes

were provided to youth, enabling them to attend purposeful appointments. Transportation is an essential stabilizing resource.



41 Social Service Partners

provided access to supportive services for youth at our drop-in center and CSV.



1,035 Volunteers

donated their time to us by volunteering in our warehouse, assisting in our CSV food pantry, and more.



1,500 Cartons of Eggs & 2,080 Gallons of Milk

were provided to youth in our drop-in center's 24/7 open kitchen.

199

youth were provided emergency assistance through programs supported by Anthem, The Columbus Foundation Gifts of Kindness Fund and NeighborRelief.

698

donation drop-offs supporting our guests' basic needs were conducted at our drop-in center.

96%

of youth who reported having issues meeting their basic needs before Star House said at least one of those issues was now easier or a non-existent problem.
